Ironwork and Welding

Nov. 2-6: Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Training covers the basics of rebar, steel erection and welding used in the ironworker trade. Stick welding (SMAW) and oxy acetylene cutting will be covered.

Sheetmetal Work

Nov. 3-4: Tuesday-Wednesday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Training covers the basics of hands-on sheet metal work and safety.

Electrial Pre-Apprenticehip

Dec. 5-19: Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday, 6-9 p.m.; and Saturdays, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.

Training covers the basics of electrical theory, electrical code, blueprints, tool safety and hands-on training including wiring of switches, GFCI receptacles, duplex receptacles, panels, 3-way and 4-way switches, bending EMT and rigid conduit.

Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW)

Jan. 12-23: Tuesday/Thursday, 6-9 p.m.; and Saturdays, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.

Training covers vertical and horizontal stick welding, oxygen and acetylene cutting, safe use of hands-on tools and materials, welding practices, identify joint design, fit-up and electrode selection.

- Complete **WorkKeys math** test. Call Midtown Job Center at **(907) 269-4759** to pre-register for the WorkKeys test.
- Provide copy of **photo ID**.
- If selected, must be able to pass a **drug test at no cost to you** before beginning training.
