Electrical Pre-Apprenticeship

Oct. 20-Nov. 5: Held 6-9 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday; and 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturday

Training covers basic electrical theory, electrical code, blueprints, tool safety and hands-on training including wiring of switches, GFCI receptacles, duplex receptacles, panels, three-way and four-way switches, bending EMT and rigid conduit.

Carpentry 1

Oct. 24-Nov. 21: Held 6-9 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday; and 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturday

Training covers the basics of carpentry, safety awareness, trades math, reading and using a tape measure; proper and safe use of power tools, building layout using the 3-4-5 method; trades math, compound cuts with a skilsaw to build a sawhorse and a set of stairs; construction site education and carpenter expectations.

Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW)

Nov. 3-19: Held 6-9 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday

Safety precautions for GMAW and awareness of the importance of safety in welding, basic understanding of the GMAW process, variables that affect the quality of welds and fit up, overview of shielding gases and the types of metal transfer associated with GMAW, hands-on skill building welding exercises.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete MCA application online.
- Complete **WorkKeys math** test. Call Mat-Su Job Center at **(907) 352-2500** to pre-register for the WorkKeys test.
- Provide copy of photo ID.
- If selected, must be able to pass a drug test at no cost to you before beginning training.
