Hydroponic tomato workers work with plants grown in a soil-less media, i.e. cocoa fiber or rockwool. Workers cut a 4-inch hole in a 39-by-8-inch flat slab and plant three to four plants at an angle in each slab. Then they secure each plant with an overhead string.

- Location: Work performed at 13700 Specking Ave. in Anchorage.
- Hours: 40 regular hours per week — 8 a.m.- 4 p.m. Monday-Friday — eight hours a day with no anticipated overtime.
- Regular pay: \$10 per hour.
- Employer will furnish all tools, supplies or equipment required to perform the work.
- Workers will NOT be engaged in work defined by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as requiring pesticide training.
- Duties: plant tomato seeds; plant seedlings; train young plants; transplant; pollinate by hand; pick, grade and label fruit for sale.
- Housing: For workers who do not live in the Anchorage area, employer will provide room and cooking facilities at no cost to the employee.
- Transportation paid for and provided by employer (on a common carrier) from recruitment point of hire to Anchorage. For workers who live in company provided housing, free transportation will be provided from the housing location to the work site and return each day.

Referred applicants will meet the following criteria:

- Must have one month prior experience in hydroponic greenhouse tomato farming: pollinating hydroponic tomatoes by hand, training young plants, picking, packing, grading and labeling fruit for sale

 2. Be able, willing and qualified to perform the work
 3. Be available at the time and place needed and for the full duration of the period of employment
 4. Be eligible for employment in the United States
