Heavy Equipment Operating:

August 13th - August 17th; 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This 40-hour introductory training covers hands-on practice on heavy equipment including hydraulic excavators, dozers and front end loaders; pre-op 360* walk-arounds, control familiarization, equipment functions and operating techniques, and safety rules and practices.

Heavy Duty Mechanics:

August 20th - August 24th; 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This 40-hour introductory training covers instruction into Heavy Duty Diesel Mechanics. Modules include: hydraulics, drivetrains, fuel systems, exhaust systems, electrical functions, and troubleshooting techniques. The proper use of tools and job site safety will be included in the instruction.

Welding Fabrication:

August 27th - August 31st; 8 a.m. to 5p.m.

This 40-hour introductory training covers the techniques used in the maintenance and repair of heavy equipment. Week 1 will be an introduction to the safe process of oxy-acetylene cutting and arc welding as well as the proper use of tools and job site safety.

FREE CONSTRUCTION TRAINING

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Be at least 18 years of age.
Have a high school diploma or GED.
Must have a valid drivers license with no DUI's in the past 3 years.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following documents are required

1. Copy of birth certificate.
2. Copy of high school diploma or GED certificate.
3. High school transcripts or GED scores.
4. Copy of social security card.
5. Copy of DD214 (Veterans only).
6. Copy of valid driver's license
7. Copies of scores from Work Keys tests:
Graphic Literacy (4 or higher)
Applied Mathematics (4 or higher)
Workplace Documents (4 or higher)
8. Optional/Recommended: resume, trade school certificates, college transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc...
