Building Science and Weatherization:

October 15th-18th, Monday-Thursday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

This training covers building science; theory of blower door use, general air sealing, attic weatherization, and using safety data sheets. Theory of identifying specific home weatherization problems along with health and safety hazards on a job.

FCA Electrical Pre-Apprenticeship:

October 15th-19th, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:30pm

Training covers basic electrical theory, electrical code, prints, tool safety and hands on training including wiring of switches, GFCI receptacles, duplex receptacles, panels, 3-way and 4-way switches, bending EMT and rigid conduit.

Power Tools:

October 22nd-25th, Monday-Thursday, 8:00am to 4:30pm

Power Tools training will cover proper safety, operation and use for a variety of power tools used in the construction industry, allowing students to develop proper safety habits and power tool operation skills. Students will construct several small projects or complete tasks using various power tools.

*Circular Saw, Power Drill, Jigsaw Router, Impact Driver, Sander, Compound Miter Saw, Pneumatic Nailer, Laser Level, Air Compressor, along with other construction related power tools.

Carpentry 80hr:

November 5th-16th, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

Training covers the proper use of hand and power tools along with math, layout, materials, and fasteners used in the construction trade. Stair layout, residential wall and roof framing will also be covered.

Sheetrock Taping:

November 19th-21st, Monday-Wednesday, 8:00am to 4:30pm

Training covers materials, handling, storage, layout, cutting, application and installation of sheetrock (drywall). Proper application of joint compound, tape and corner bead to provide finished appearance to sheetrock.

Residential Framing:

November 26th-30th, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

Training covers wall layout using 16 and 24 inch layout, design placement & use of wall framing components, conventional roof framing techniques for wood rafters and ceiling joist, and methods of layout.

Ironwork and Welding:

November 26th-30th, Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm

Training covers the basics of rebar, steel erection and welding used in the Ironworker Trade. Stick welding (SMAW) and oxy acetylene cutting will be covered.
