FEMA Transportation Assistance – What you need to know

For eligible families who remain displaced from their homes due to Typhoon Halong.

FEMA Transportation Assistance may pay for round-trip airfare from their temporary residence to approved locations and back again for:

- meeting with FEMA inspectors
- or for subsistence activities.

Who is eligible?

Qualified homeowners and renters that:

- Are approved for FEMA assistance.
- Remain displaced from their pre-disaster home.
- Have not received travel funds for the same trip from a tribe, charity, nonprofit or other organization.



What is covered?

- Up to two roundtrip flights for each eligible household member.
- Standard baggage fees for each flight (up to \$100).
- Airline fees for pets or service animals.
- Costs associated with accessibility needs.

What's not covered?

- Overweight or oversized baggage fees.
- Ground transportation, meals and lodging.

Any restrictions?

- The program ends on April 23, 2027.
