

DR-4893-AK Typhoon Halong Household Winterization & Debris Removal Assistance



The State of Alaska is working with recovery partners to help eligible households affected by Typhoon Halong. This effort is intended to support survivors with emergency winterization and disaster-related debris removal so households can remain safer through winter conditions.



What Help May Be Available?

- Emergency winterization of storm-damaged homes
- Temporary weatherproofing and securing openings
- Moisture control and minor temporary repairs
- Limited heat or fuel-related stabilization
- Private property debris removal when disaster debris creates an immediate threat to health, safety, access, or recovery



Who Should Complete the Form?

- Households whose homes or residential property were damaged by Typhoon Halong
- Survivors seeking winterization help or private property debris removal
- Households that can provide authorization for recovery partners to enter the property



Important

- Completing the form does not guarantee work will be performed
- Work must be determined necessary, eligible, and appropriate
- Recovery partners may need to inspect and document the property
