# A SMOOTHER PATH TO A BRIGHTER FUTURE.

Certain young people may qualify for expedited enrollment, which accelerates their application process and entry into Job Corps, if they are:

- **Experiencing homelessness**
- Survivors of severe trafficking
- Victims of natural or man-made disasters

### **HOW DOES EXPEDITED ENROLLMENT WORK?**

- 1. Applicants can self-attest to many of Job Corps' eligibility criteria—including age, U.S. citizenship/ resident/work authorization status, and income level-and provide documentation later. They can immediately start living and learning on a Job Corps campus after completing a background check and health review.
- 2. After self-attesting for one or more criteria, an applicant is deemed conditionally eligible and can continue with the next steps in the admissions process.
- 3. Once an expedited student arrives on campus, Job Corps staff will verify their self-attested aspects of eligibility by obtaining relevant documentation within 90 days. If that documentation is not received, the applicant will be separated from the program but will retain reinstatement rights.

## TALK TO AN ADMISSIONS REPRESENTATIVE TO LEARN WHETHER YOUR STUDENT QUALIFIES FOR EXPEDITED ENROLLMENT.

For Veterans, Transitioning Service Members and Military Spouses: Job Corps also offers priority enrollment for those who have been separated, regardless of discharge type, as well as their eligible spouses.

For Youth Exiting Foster Care: If your student has been in the foster care system in the last six months, they are automatically eligible for the program.
