Pay: The pay rate starts at \$16.85 per hour with additional overtime available at \$25.27 per hour, based on processing needs. The pay rate for Seafood Processors has a tiered scale based on experience. The schedule is starting at 35 hours per week however there may be significant overtime available.

It is not uncommon for shifts to be up to 16 hours per day and significant amounts of overtime to be available based on fish coming through the plant and the production schedule. **The job opportunity is a temporary, full-time position.**

Daily travel to worksites in the area of intended employment is required. The requested temporary workers will be based at 4400 Sawmill Creek Road, Suite B, Sitka, AK 99835, and will service worksites within the Alaska nonmetropolitan

area, including the counties of Sitka; Kodiak Island; Bristol Bay; Prince of Wales-Hyder; Valdez-Cordova, Prince William Sound, Aleutians East Borough. Employer provides transportation to and from all worksites.
